

Minutes Of the A.G.M. held at
The Railway Hotel, on Saturday, 13th April, 1969

The meeting was opened with Mr. Porcher in the chair. Mr. Porcher spoke of the death of Mr. Dames in September last year. He felt that this would be a great loss to the Club, but our memories of him would remain with us. The Secretary was then requested to play the tape of Mr. Dames message to Old Harlovians made two years ago.

In view of the loss of our President it then followed the election of ~~XXXXXX~~ our new President. The Secretary had no hesitation in proposing Mr. S. Porcher, who had always taken an active part in Old Harlovians activities. This was seconded by M.C. Clayden and carried unanimously. It was then proposed by B. Reid and seconded by M. Collins that the existing Committee be re-elected en-block for the coming year.

The Secretary was able to relate the details of the death of Mr. Dames and the action taken by the committee on behalf of the members.

The Treasurer reported that there was an excess of expenditure over income of £3. 12. 11. The balance shown was £191. 8. 2.

In any other business it was agreed that the committee should go ahead with placing a plaque in the porchway of the old School Chapel to commemorate the Old Harlovians who died in the 1939/45 war. with regard to the Memorial for Mr. Dames it was suggested that we delay our plans as it was understood that the Harlow Development corporation had plans in mind to ~~now~~ build a school or students quarters on the site of the Old School and it was felt that Mr. Dames name ~~shaly~~ should be linked with the school.

The feeling of the members was that in order to instill new enthusiasm in the Old Harlovians Club that the reunion should now take a different form. The members gave the Committee full authority to arrange a cabaret as entertainment at next years reunion and revise the A.G.M. by possibly pinning the various reports to a notice board.

There being no other business the meeting then closed with a vote of thanks to the chair.
