Alternative materials were then discussed. The meeting was informed that the Club had made a contribution of £45.00 to repairs to the St. John's Church lych gate. The repairs had cost £87.00. An order for 2. doz. ties had been placed with Geoff. Lampard's Company and delivery was expected in the near future.

The Treasurer then made his report. The 1975 dinner had shown a profit of £43.00, mostly from the raffle, prizes for which had been donated by the President. Mr. Geoff. Ashwell queried a balance of .40p in the Westminster Bank account. A satisfactory explanation was provided by the Treasurer and the report accepted, proposed by Geoff. Venue for 1976 A.G.M., J.Foulds suggestion for the Masonic Hall at Potters Street met with a mixed reception. After discussing it's many virtues the Painted Lady, Harlow was suggested. After more discussion and some phone calls to the Painted Lady this was decided on as the venue. Date, 8.5.76, time 7 pm. for 7.30 pm., price £3.50 each. Messrs S.Porcher, R.Minall and R. West to visit The Painted Lady to finalise the arrangements. (this visit took place on 18.2.76

S.Porcher informed the meeting that repairs to the St. Johns Church lytch gate had now been completed at a cost to the P.C.C. of £87.00. The question of a contribution to these repair from club funds was discussed. A contribution of £45.00 was proposed by G.Ashwell, seconded J. Pryor. A counter proposal for a contribution of £25.00 was made by I.Taylor, seconded R.West. The proposal for £45.00 was carried on a show of hands. S.Porcher suggested that the £45.00 should be paid from the War Memorial fund, proposed R.Minall, seconded J.Foulds. It was further suggested that a letter to Rev. Weller regarding the K.L.Dames proposed Memorial should accompany the cheque.
