These item include the school bell, a portrait of K.L.Dames, a painting of the College by an ex. pupil, a hand bell, the school cups and misc. photographs. Several members present thought that it would be a good idea to offer a cup to St. Nicholas.

Club officers were re elected en bloc. It was proposed that David rish should be co-opted on to the committee to take the place of Geoff. Ashwell who had been ill for some time.

Micheal Dyke asked if the date of the future annual meeting could be brought forward to February. There was no support for this request.
