MINUTES OF THE 1981 A.G.M. HELD AT THE
MASONIC HALL, POTTERS STREET, 6 JUNE 1981.

The meeting was attended by thirty six members, apologies for absence were received from nineteen members. Minutes of the 1980 meeting were read, matters arising were as follows. Mr S. Porcher informed the meeting that a cup had been purchased for presenting to St Nicholas School and that David Zisk should be approached re the presentation. The Harlow Museum was willing to accept the College War Memorial plaques at present in the porch of St Johns Church, but not at this precise moment. They would also be interested in any other College relics and the possibility of an occasional exhibition did exist. The meeting gave Mr Porcher authority to liaise with the Museum.

The Treasurer regretfully reported the first loss since he had held office. This was due to the purchase of the cup. There had been income from investments and a small profit from the dinner. A query arose as to whether the sum of £30.00 had been paid for repairs to St Johns lych gate, Mr. Porcher promised to look into this. In view of the present circumstances surrounding St Johns it was decided there would be no more payments made for upkeep of the lych gate. Copies of the accounts were displayed.

Election of Officers. M. Dyke asked if the committee should be reduced, to say President, V. President, Treasurer, Secretary and ? members. G. Poyor suggested four members would be sufficient. S. Porcher proposed, for the time being, i.e. until next A.G.M., present committee should be re-elected en bloc.

Any O.B. returned the meeting to the cup. The meeting was informed that C. Porcher had purchased

the cup at a cost of \$150.00, it had been engraved
F.O.C. and was considered, at present values to be
worth around \$400.00. C. Hockley proposed authorising
the expenditure of \$150.00, the meeting was in agreement
with this proposal. The question then arose of 'what
should the cup be awarded for?' It was left that
David Fish would be asked to discuss this with
St Nicholas school whilst arranging for its presentation.
