The Treasurer reported that the current

Society.

A lengthy discussion followed regarding
the transfer of Harlow College to Crofton Grange
Parkside. The Secretary gave an up-to-date
account of events which had taken place
at various meetings held by the Steering
Committee of the Harlow College Educational
Trust. It was agreed that the Committee could
not allow the Secretary to bear the financial
burden of becoming a trustee to represent the
Old Harlovians and it was further agreed that
as the future of the Trust was uncertain at the
moment, all monies received from Old Harlovians
should be frozen until directed by the President.
The President, K. L. James stated that he would
write to Mr. Richardson, Chairman of the
Steering Committee advising him of our decision.

For future activities it was agreed the
Secretary should arrange for the Annual Dinner
and General Meeting to take place at the
Painted Lady, Harlow, in March.

The Meeting closed with a vote of
thanks to Mr. James for taking the chair and
his hospitality.

The Painted Lady on SAT 20th March 1965 at 8.30 P.M.

The Chair was taken by our President, Mr. K. L. Dames. The meeting opened with the general procedure of reading the minutes and these were passed unanimously. Following this, Mr Dames spoke to the members present of the closure of the school. He regretted having to take this decision but added that the number of boys had fallen from 200 to 150 and at the same time staff salaries had risen. Extensive repairs on the school were now required, the cost of which would be beyond the finances of the school. With regard to the future of the Old Harlovians, Mr. Dames hoped that this would continue for at least 30 to 40 years.

The Secretary reported that the events arranged by the Committee which had taken place were the raffle on Sports Day, which had raised £11. 10. = net, a fairly successful Barbecue at the school at the end of Sports Day despite torrential rain. A Buffet-Dance also took place but this was attended by only 60 old boys and friends. ~~The secretary felt that~~

The Sports Secretary reported that there had been one football match with the score Old Boys 8 against the school 12.
