

OLD HARLOVIANS CLUB

Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held at the St. Johns Arts and Recreation Centre on Saturday, 12th May 1990

A record number of 63 Members attended the Meeting.

The President opened the Meeting by welcoming those attending and thanking John West for the excellent catering.

The Secretary read the Minutes of the 1989 Meeting and these were duly signed as a true record. There were no matters arising. The Secretary then read the Newsletter from 1965, which described the closing of the School and the vain attempts to find alternative premises.

The President reported the recent death of Jack Jones, who died on 25th April, and it was suggested that the Old Harlovians Club should send a donation to the Asthma Research Council. This was generally agreed and a sum of twenty five pounds was approved.

The Treasurer then presented his Report, which showed that the Club has a balance of £882.22. The acceptance of these Accounts was proposed by Peter Cottee and seconded by Malcolm Norris. There was one item under Matters Arising from the Accounts; it was suggested that some of the money should be put into a higher interest account.

Election of Officers and Committee: The Secretary, Treasurer and Committee were all unanimously re-elected en bloc.

As a follow-up to the previous year's suggestion that a cup or cups should be given to St. Nicholas School to keep the name of Harlow College alive, it was suggested to the Meeting that the K.L. Dames "Good Samaritan" Cup be presented. This was felt to be the most appropriate, particularly as St. Nicholas School wanted the cup for "good citizenship", and, due to the positioning and quantity of the engraving, it would be a simple matter to adapt it.

David Collins formally proposed the acceptance of this scheme, which was seconded by Richard Atkins and passed unanimously.

Due to the success of the 1990 Reunion and Dinner, it was decided that for 1991 the Meeting should again take place at St. Johns Arts and Recreation Centre, and that John West should be asked to do the catering. The 18th May was proposed, so as to avoid the Bank Holiday weekends, and this was accepted.

Under Any Other Business, a vote of thanks was proposed to the organisers for the very good evening.

Roger Kenningale suggested that a levy should be applied to all those members not wearing an Old Harlovian tie. This proposal was not carried.

Ken Muir proposed that a banner be put up, depicting the school badge and motto, in what was the Chapel. This met with a great deal of approval. A suggestion that a brass plaque could also be erected in the building was raised as well. Tony Cook offered to obtain a quotation for the making of the banner.

Tony Eastwood proposed that some money be used as a book prize for St. Nicholas School. There were several comments for and against this idea, but the President did comment that St. Nicholas School has a large quantity of cups and prizes already, and he did not think that additional prizes were particularly sought after. The suggestion was turned down by the Meeting.

The President then thanked everyone for attending and closed the Meeting at 10.50 p.m.
