Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held at the St. Johns Arts and Recreation Centre on Saturday 13th May 1995

40 members attended the Meeting.

1. The Minutes of the 1994 A.G.M., having been circulated to all Members, were taken as read. Their adoption was proposed by Barry Reid and seconded by Stan Porcher. There were no matters arising.

2. The Treasurer reported that the income for the year ended 28th February 1995 totalled £1350.50, with a total expenditure of £1698.45, giving a balance of £1269.20, £385.70 having been donated to the lychgate appeal at St. Johns. The adoption of the Accounts was proposed by Bill Billing, seconded by Roger Pyle.

3. Election of Secretary: Michael Dyke was re-elected by the Meeting on the proposal of Henry Smith-Daye, seconded by Andrew Brown.

4. Election of Treasurer: Unfortunately Michael Slater is emigrating to California and therefore had to tender his resignation. However, Richard Morgan proposed Tony Cook as his replacement, and this was seconded by Michael Collins. The proposal was carried by the Meeting.

5. The remainder of the Committee was re-elected en bloc, on the proposal of Stan Porcher, seconded by Vic Bellingham, and carried unanimously.

6. Plaque. The erection of a plaque depicting the school badge, plus the wording suggested in the 1995 annual circular, was agreed by the Meeting on a majority vote after the deletion of the word "daily", the proposed site being immediately to the left of the arch to the chancel.

7. Photograph. At the 1994 A.G.M. it was suggested that a large photograph of the School be hung in St. Johns. Suitable photographs were requested of the Meeting. However, no new material was forthcoming, so David Illsley is looking into the possibility of enlarging a couple of old photos.

8. Blazer badges. The sample was shown to the Meeting, and met with much approval. Slight correction to two of the colours is required, but this will be done when they are made.

9. Memorabilia. Members' attention was drawn to the existence of cufflinks, tiepins etc., depicting the school badge, which were available.

10. It was agreed that the next Meeting would be on Saturday, 18th May 1996, at St. Johns A.R.C., with John West as caterer again.

11. Any other business: The Chairman, Roger Pyle, who has been involved with the construction of a water treatment plant for Thames Water at Ashford Common, near Heathrow, for the last four years, offered members a conducted tour.

A vote of thanks was proposed by Peter Cottee, and the Meeting closed at 10.45 p.m.
