Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held at St. Johns Arts and Recreation Centre on Saturday 17 May 1997

- 41 Members attended the Meeting.
- 1. The Minutes of the 1996 AGM were taken as read, as they had been previously circulated to all members. Their adoption was proposed by John Pryor, seconded by Norman Pegrum, and carried unanimously. There were no matters arising.
- 2. Treasurer's Report. Tony Cook had changed the Old Harlovians account from the Natwest Bank to Lloyds Bank at Bishops Stortford for his convenience. He also asked for the Meeting to vote on whether or not the money should be made available to re-silver the plated cups, which could be done as a job lot through Colin Porcher for £300. The Meeting agreed. The Treasurer presented the accounts and reported an income of £872 for the year 1996/97, with outgoings of £960, therefore showing a deficit of £88 for the year. The Club has funds to the value of £974. The adoption of these accounts was proposed by John Pryor, seconded by Tony White, and carried unanimously.
- 3. Election of Officers. The Secretary, Michael Dyke, and the Treasurer, Tony Cook, were both re-elected unanimously.
- 4. **The Committee**, consisting of Chairman Roger Pyle, Alan Careless, Colin Porcher, John Pryor, Michael Slater and Bob West, were all re-elected en bloc.
- 5. Lych Gate. The Secretary had been approached by the St Johns committee to see if the Old Harlovians would take on the care and maintenance of the Lych Gate. This suggestion was put to the Meeting but it was agreed not to take on this liability.
- 6. A large framed copy of a **photograph** of Harlow College had been produced by David Illsley. It was suggested that it could be hung on the right of the chancel arch.
- 7. It had been suggested that **wooden shields** depicting the school badge could be made available, but there was very little interest from the Meeting, and this suggestion will not be proceeded with unless more interest is shown.
- 8. Date of next Meeting. It was agreed to change the date, initially as a trial for one year only, to June, i.e. June 6th, for 1998, at St. Johns, with John West as caterer.

9. Any Other Business.

- (a) Due to the relatively low sale of alcohol, John West has to make a charge to supply bar facilities. The Meeting was asked whether they would prefer to pay this charge or bring their own drink, and it was agreed to carry on with the full bar facilities.
- (b) Robert Collins proposed that the ticket price, which had been held at £20 for a few years now, should be increased to £25, as the total costs of the evening are not being covered by the current ticket price. This was approved by the members.
- (c) There was a suggestion that a list of past masters of the school should be compiled, plus their subjects, but this received little enthusiasm from the Meeting and therefore will not be proceeded with.

The Meeting closed at 10.35 pm.
