- 1. The Minutes of the 1998 AGM were taken as read as they had been previously circulated to all members. Their adoption was carried unanimously and there were no matters arising.

- 4. **Election of Chairman.** Roger Pyle was proposed by Michael Dyke, seconded by Richard Atkins, and this was carried unanimously.
- 5. **Election of Secretary.** Michael Dyke was proposed by Richard Atkins, seconded by John Pryor, and this was carried unanimously.
- 6. **Election of Treasurer.** Tony Cook was proposed by John Pryor, seconded by Malcolm Seward, and this was carried unanimously.
- 7. **Secretary's Deputy.** Bob West volunteered to deputize for the Secretary, especially in matters local to Harlow, as the elected Secretary (Michael Dyke) has now moved away from the district.
- 8. **Date and Venue of next Meeting.** It was agreed that the next Meeting would be on the 10th June 2000 at St. John's Arts and Recreation Centre, and that John West should act as caterer.

9. Any other business.

- a) It was proposed from the floor that next year the ticket price should be raised to £26, and this was accepted by the Meeting.
- **b)** The Chairman brought to the attention of the members present the costs the Secretary entailed to maintain and repair the photocopier used for producing the annual reports, etc., and it was agreed that a contribution would be made towards these costs.
