

# OLD HARLOVIANS CLUB

## MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 17 MAY 2003 at ST. JOHN'S ARTS AND RECREATION CENTRE

39 members attended the Meeting.

1. **The Minutes of the 2002 AGM** were taken as read as they had been circulated to all members. Adoption of the Minutes was proposed by Richard Baldry (59-65) and seconded by Philip Alexander (61-63). Passed unanimously.
2. **Treasurer's Report.** The Treasurer, Tony Cook (48-57), reported a total income of £1258 and a total expenditure of £897, giving a surplus of £361. This leaves a reserve of £1587. There were no matters arising. Adoption was proposed by Malcolm Norris (50-55) and seconded by Richard Atkins (50-58). Carried unanimously.
3. **Election of Officers.** The office holders were re-elected en bloc: Chairman; Roger Pyle (53-58). Secretary; Michael Dyke (50-58). Treasurer; Tony Cook. Re-election proposed by David Collins (39-42) and seconded by Gerald Searing (50-52). Carried unanimously.
4. **Members' telephone numbers.** The Meeting again allowed their telephone numbers to be appended to the Members Attending list to be sent out in 2004, to facilitate communications.
5. **Date and Venue of next Meeting.** A long debate ensued involving the system of alternating the A.G.M. between May and June, some members preferring it to be fixed in May. The Secretary pointed out that four of our regular attendants were unable to come on this date in May, and on a vote a large majority were in favour of the status quo. The Meeting agreed that the next AGM would be held on the 12<sup>th</sup> June 2004 at St. Johns ARC. with Walker Catering supplying the food.
6. **Any Other Business.**
  - (a) John Parsons (41-51) as President of the Talbot Car Association announced a rally at his house in June.
  - (b) Thanks were given to the officers for their stalwart work during the year.
  - (c) Chris McCready (61-64) was thanked by the Chairman for setting up the website.
  - (d) David Collins said that it had been an excellent evening, and the caterers had done a superb job.
  - (e) Apologies had been received from Tony White (51-56) and Hugh Jones (56-63), who were unable to attend at the last moment.
  - (f) The Chairman asked how many members were attending for the first time, and four people responded. Donald Graham (44-52) said that this was his first Reunion for 51 years!
  - (g) The Chairman informed the Meeting of the deaths of four Old Harlovians: Peter Chivers (32-41), Fred Scatley (-55), David Graham (35-42) and John Foulds (32-35). John Foulds had served on the Committee, and had hosted a number of committee meetings.
  - (h) David Collins will send the Secretary a list he has of the boys at the School and their exam results for 1941.

The Meeting closed at 10.37 pm.
