MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

HELD on 15TH MAY 2010

36 members attended the meeting.

1. **The Chairman welcomed everyone to the Meeting**, especially the three new attendees, Peter Lloyd (51-56), Brian Power (39-46) and George Cronin (60-63). By coincidence seven members of the same class (1945) happened to be sitting on the same table.
2. **Minutes of the 2009 AGM** were taken as read. Their adoption was proposed by Barry Reid (53-58), seconded by Michael Collins (44-50) and passed unanimously.
3. **Treasurer's Report.** Colin Porcher (46-54) reported that the total income for the year 2009/10 was £911, with an expenditure of £1183, leaving a deficit of £272, with a bank deposit of £1670. The adoption of his report was proposed by Robert Collins (40-45), seconded by Howard Bodger (41-46) and passed unanimously. There were no matters arising, but Colin Porcher commented that Harlow Museum will stay open for the foreseeable future, and they were looking for a prefect's cap.
4. **Election of Officers.** The re-election of Chairman Roger Pyle (53-58), Secretary Michael Dyke (50-58) and Treasurer Colin Porcher (46-54) was proposed by Michael Collins (44-50), seconded by Richard Baldry (59-65) and passed unanimously.
5. **Members' telephone numbers and email addresses.** The Meeting again allowed their telephone numbers and email addresses to be appended to the Members' Directory.
6. **Date and venue of next Meeting.** The Meeting agreed that the next AGM will be on the 14th May 2011, at St. John's A.R.C. with Walker Catering providing the meal. There was a long debate and several proposals and counter-proposals regarding the date for future meetings. Finally the proposal by Richard Baldry (59-65), seconded by David Fish (44-49), that the AGM/Reunion be held on the third Saturday in May, was carried unanimously.
7. **Cost of Web Site.** Chris McCready (61-65), the "Webmaster", had asked previously if anybody would be prepared to help towards the cost of the web site, which amounts to approximately £75 per annum. The Meeting did feel that he should be supported in his efforts and that the Club make up any shortfall. On a proposal by Roger Brickwood (62-65), £75 would be reserved in the Accounts, so that Chris McCready would be able to clarify the situation to the Members at next year's Reunion, as he was unable to attend this year at the last moment.
8. **Price of next year's Dinner.** The Secretary explained that there were significant increases in costs of the meal and the hall anticipated for next year which, coupled with the possible expenditure on the web site, could amount to £4 - £5 per person. On a proposal from Barry Reid (53-58), the price for next year was provisionally set at £30 maximum. Due to the financial situation John Parsons (41-51) proposed that the raffle prize of a free ticket should be withdrawn, and this was also agreed.
9. **Any Other Business.**
 - (a) John Upsall (59-64) proposed that the cups be sold for scrap to raise funds. This proposal was turned down after Don Graham (44-52) said that his father had presented a cup, and he wants it left in the Club's hands until his death! Colin Porcher said that the Foster Stevenson cup, "Missing over Germany", must be kept.
 - (b) Robert Collins proposed a vote of thanks to the Committee for their work.

The meeting closed at 11 p.m.
