### MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING Held on 19<sup>th</sup> MAY 2018

33 Members attended the meeting.

- 1. **Chairman's opening remarks**: The Chairman, Roger Pyle (53-58) welcomed all those present, especially Peter Smith (56-62), who had never attended one of these functions before. He also read out the recent additions to our Obituary list: Graham Carter (50-54) and Hugh Findlay.
- 2. **Minutes of the 2017 AGM**: These had been circulated to all members prior to the meeting, and were taken as read.
- 3. **Adoption of Minutes:** Their adoption was proposed by Chris Giffin (55-65) and seconded by John Pryor (58-64). Carried unanimously.
- 4. **Matters arising:** The Chairman had visited Harlow Museum and reported that all the Harlow College material was stored and unobtainable. He also took photos of the war memorial boards which are stored at the Museum but belong to the Old Harlovians. Colin Porcher (46-54) said he had a letter to show they are only on loan to the Museum.
- 5. **Treasurer's Report:** This stated that the total income for the year 2017/18 was £1454, with an expenditure of £1151, giving a surplus of £303. The donations and raffle made a large contribution to these figures, for which we are very grateful. The higher attendance also helped to generate a profit. The Bank Deposit stands at £2769. Adoption of the Accounts was proposed by David Fish (44-49) and seconded by Barry Pyle (57-63). Carried unanimously. We need to continue this higher attendance in future years for the evening to be socially and financially viable. There were no matters arising.
- 6. **Election of Officers:** Re-election en bloc of Roger Pyle (53-58) as Chairman, Michael Dyke (50-58) as Secretary and Colin Porcher (46-54) as Treasurer was carried unanimously. Proposed by Malcolm Norris (50-55) and seconded by Tony White (51-56).
- 7. **Time of Day of AGM/Reunion:** It had been suggested by one or two members that maybe a midday lunch, rather than an evening dinner, would be easier for travelling, but this was turned down by the Meeting.
- 8. **Date and Venue of next Meeting:** The meeting agreed that the next AGM would be on 18th May 2019, at St. John's ARC, with Walker Catering providing the meal.
- 9. **Silver Cups:** The Secretary said that the silver cups will be made available shortly, and that he will circularise all the members with details of what is available, including weights and names on the various cups. The Meeting agreed that a charge of £10 per ounce would be made (the scrap value of silver is slightly higher).
- 10. **The General Data Protection Regulations:** On 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018 these new EC regulations come into force. Graham Keeler (54-58) said that we would not be able to process any data (members' addresses, years at the School, etc.) without being covered. One way would be to ask every member to agree to our utilising their information. An alternative method ("Legitimate Interest Rules") would allow us to carry on as before, but it meant producing a Legitimate Interest Assessment, which Graham Keeler had prepared, and this was adopted by the Meeting. (Copies of the Privacy Policy are available on the website or from the Secretary on request). The Members' Directory has had to be removed from the website.
- 11. **Any Other Business:** (a) Richard Atkins (50-58) proposed a vote of thanks to the Committee. (b) The Chairman is holding a number of artefacts, School bell, photos, portrait of K.L. Dames, etc., which are in need of homes. (c) Colin Porcher proposed raising the cost of the evening to £30. Seconded by Peter Smith and passed by the members.

The Meeting closed at 10.07 p.m.
