## RULES 1963

1. The Club shall be called the "Old Harlovians Club" and Old Boys and past and present masters shall be eligible for membership.

2. The members shall have power to elect Honorary Members.

3. The object of the Club shall be to promote and stimulate fellowship amongst Old Harlovians, and maintain the interest of Old Boys in the School and to further its welfare in every possible way. *THIS CLUB IN*

4. There shall be a President and Vice-Presidents elected by the members to serve as life officers.

5. There shall be a Secretary and an Assistant if necessary.

6. There shall be a Treasurer.

7. The Club shall be managed by a committee consisting of the President—Vice-Presidents—Secretary—Treasurer and 9 members to be elected annually but eligible for re-election (Except life officers see rule 4). Four to form a quorum.

8. The Secretary shall summon a meeting of the Committee at least once each year.

9. The duties of the committee shall include the organisation of sports activities and social functions for the benefit of the members.

10. The Accounts of the Club shall be audited annually by someone not a member of the Committee.

11. Every Harlow College Boy on leaving school, shall be invited to join the Club, by the Headmaster.

12. The subscription for Life Membership shall be £1 1s. 0d.

13. Members shall notify any change of address to the Secretary.

14. Invitations to school functions such as Speech Day shall be sent to all members by the Secretary.

15. None but members of the Club shall be eligible to play in Old Harlovian Matches against the School.

16. The Secretary shall summon a general meeting annually and a special meeting if called upon to do so either by the Committee or on the written request of not less than twelve members.

17. Ten days notice of the Special General Meeting stating the business to be brought forward shall be sent to each

member. No other business shall be discussed at the meeting. The quorum at such a meeting to be twenty.

18. The rules of the Club can be altered only at a General Meeting.
