RULES 1952

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1. The Club shall be called the "OLD HARLOVIANS CLUB," and Old Boys, and past and present masters shall be eligible for membership.
2. The Committee shall have power to elect Honorary Members.
3. The objects of the Club shall be to promote intercourse between the Old Boys, to maintain the interest of Old Boys in the School and to promote its welfare in every possible way.
4. There shall be a President and Vice-Presidents.
5. There shall be a Secretary.
6. There shall be a Treasurer.
7. Every Harlow College boy, on leaving school, shall be invited to join the Club by the Headmaster.

8. The subscription for Life Membership shall be £1 1s. 0d.

9. Every member shall receive a copy of each issue of "*The Harlovian*" subject to payment being made for each copy.

10. The Club shall be managed by a Committee, consisting of the President, Vice-Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer and twelve members, to be elected annually but eligible for re-election. Four to form a quorum.

11. The Club shall have power to elect certain Vice-Presidents for life.

12. The Secretary shall summon a meeting of the Committee at least once each year.

13. The accounts of the Club shall be audited annually by someone not a member of the Committee.

14. There shall be an Annual Dinner and Dance, at the discretion of the Committee, at a place to be decided upon by the Committee.

15. The duties of the Committee shall include the organisation of all games against the School, and the appointment of Captains and Vice-Captains of the various teams.

16. A list of members of the Club, with addresses shall be printed and sent to all members.

17. Members shall notify any change of address to the Secretary.

18. There shall be an Old Harlovian Editor to the Magazine, elected by the Committee as occasion arise to deal with all correspondence from Old Boys, in connection with the Old Harlovian section of the Magazine.

19. Invitations to School functions, such as Speech Day, shall be sent to all members by the Secretary.

20. None but members of the Club shall be eligible to play in Old Harlovian matches against the School.

21. The Secretary shall summon a general meeting annually, and a special general meeting if called upon to do so either by the Committee or on the written request of not less than twelve members.

22. Ten days' notice of the Special General Meeting, stating the business to be brought forward, shall be sent to each member. No other business shall be discussed at the meeting.

The quorum at such a meeting to be twenty.

23. The rules of the Club can be altered only at a general meeting.
